5)	What are other ways Emmaline could have behaved toward Evie that would have made her feel good about herself?
6)	Was it hard for Emmaline to tell her mother what she had done at school?
7)	Is it hard for someone to say they are sorry?
8)	What would someone say to their classmates if they had behaved badly and wanted to apologize?
9)	Why is it important for people to take responsibility for their actions?
