TRANSFER OF RIGHTS AT AGE OF MAJORITY

All of the rights enjoyed by the student's parent(s) under Part B of IDEA and related state law will transfer to the student upon reaching the age of majority (18), unless a legal guardian or conservator is appointed.

Although IEP forms vary from one district to the next, all must include the requirements defined in federal and state laws. This resource covers a portion of the IEP Form with all the required parts of an IEP that are outlined in the federal regulations and gives an example of how an IEP form may look. Some sections of the IEP require discussion, but the documentation of the discussion on the IEP form may be optional. School districts will want to document that a particular requirement was discussed.
