

Creating an ePub file

Why?

Epub is the file format that is used by many different digital book readers like the Nook, iPad, Sony eReader, Kobo eReader and more. Putting your materials in this format make them accessible to these devices and their accessibility features like resizable text and text to voice.



Resources

- www.epub2go.com is a free website that lets you upload a PDF file and have it automatically converted to ePub format. Easy and fast but pictures and formatted text don't always convert just right. Works great for simply laid out documents.
- Calibre www.calibre-ebook.com is a free program that converts PDF and several other formats to ePub files. Simply load your PDF into Calibre and hit the convert button. Calibre can handle images better than Epub2Go so it is a good option for more complex documents. Calibre works for both Windows and Mac.
- Apple Pages '09 www.apple.com/iwork/pages is a Mac word processing program similar to Microsoft Word, but with a ePub export option. With Pages you are able to really customize the way your ePub will look and create an index that the reader can use to navigate a larger document.
