Award for Excellence in Transition-Focused Parent Training

WHAT CAN BE SUBMITTED?

Training sessions, workshops, curricula, research, and youth-and parent-friendly publications that can serve as national models may be submitted. Products should help youth with disabilities or their family members master key concepts or build skills that will help prepare youth for employment and a successful transition from school to adulthood in the areas of higher education, careers, independent living, community participation, health maintenance, or access to adult service systems.

SELECTION CRITERIA

A selection committee of parent trainers and other transition stakeholders will consider the degree to which materials:

1. reflect current research
2. utilize innovative formats
3. can be accessed online and downloaded at minimal to no cost
4. are available in accessible formats
5. can be replicated easily by others
6. incorporate interactive activities reflective of adult learning
7. model creative use of collaborations
8. promote youth leadership and youth development
9. contain an evaluation component

AWARD

The winning parent center will receive:

- an expense-paid opportunity for one staff member to attend the 2012 TATRA National Conference on May 7 in Charlotte, NC
- promotion of the award-winning materials in TATRA's Reference Points electronic bulletin service and newsletter
